- Regular assessments: Work through a skills matrix to track progress and ensure competency in required skills.

2. Achieving Level 2 NVQ:

- Completion of trainee program: Once at the required experience/skill level, you will be enrolled into the NVQ and ready for assessment.
- Assessment and certification: Pass the assessments to earn a Level 2 NVQ in power-operated automatic doors and skilled worker CSCS card.
